Inter-Faith Journey To **Israel** TOUR SCHEDULE

DAY 1

Monday, October 23, 2017

USA / EN ROUTE

Depart the United States flying overnight to **Israel**.

DAY 2

Tuesday, October 24, 2017

TEL AVIV/TIBERIAS

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in **Tel Aviv**, directly on the **Mediterranean Sea** and **Israel's largest city**. Meet, assist and begin the journey traveling up the Israeli coastline to **Caesarea**, the Roman capital of Israel. View the beautiful restored **Roman Theater, the ruins of the ancient town, harbor and aqueduct** before continuing to **Tiberias**. (D)

DAY 3

Wednesday, October 25, 2017

TIBERIAS

Join together this morning for a **special service** on the **waters of the Sea of Galilee**. Continue to the **Mount of Beatitudes**, the site of the **Sermon on the Mount**. Onto **Capernaum**, residence of Jesus during his ministry in the Galilee and the location of several of his miracles. See the ruins of the **ancient synagogue**. Next, visit **Magdala**, home of Mary Magdalene and the location of a newly excavated first century synagogue, currently the oldest in the Galilee and one of only seven from that period in all of Israel. Stop to view the **ancient boat** at **Nof Ginnosar**. Proceed to **Tabgha**, the traditional site of the **miracle of loaves and fishes**. Conclude the day with a **Baptism** in the **Jordan River, at the beautiful site of Yardenit**. This evening enjoy a **Galilean style grill dinner** on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

DAY 4

Thursday, October 26, 2017

TIBERIAS/GOLAN HEIGHTS

Morning tour of the **Golan Heights**, seeing the **former Syrian fortifications**, and understanding the strategic importance of this area. View the road to Damascus, driving past **Mount Hermon** to **Mt. Bental**, an excellent lookout point towards **Syria in the east**, the **Hermon slopes in the north** and northern **Golan Heights**. Continue to **Caesarea Philippi** where Peter first confessed Jesus as Christ. The afternoon, drive by **Mt. Precipice** to **Nazareth**, the **boyhood home of Jesus**. (B,D)

DAY 5

Friday, October 27, 2017

TIBERIAS/JERUSALEM

With **gifts in hand**, this morning, visit **IDF soldiers** patrolling and keeping Israel safe on her northern border. Next, visit **Safed**, one of the **Four Holy Cities** according to tradition and known for its mystical atmosphere and Kabbalistic studies. This town was a center of 16th century mysticism and is still a magnet for spiritual "searchers". Absorb the special ambience of contrasts, where ancient synagogues and modern art galleries exist side by side. Explore the narrow, winding alleys. Visit some of the **beautiful synagogues** and browse through the **artists' workshops and galleries** found in the flourishing artist quarter. Next, drive up to **Jerusalem**, enjoying a **welcome service** reciting a **special "Shehechyanu"** atop **Mount Scopus** upon arrival.

As the sun sets, proceed to the **Western Wall (Kotel)** for the traditional bringing in of the **Sabbath. Shabbat dinner** at the hotel this evening. (B,D)

DAY 6

Saturday, October 28, 2017

JERUSALEM

Begin the day with a view of the beautiful panorama from atop the **Mount of Olives**. Walk **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane for a special service**. Proceed to **Mount Zion** visiting the **Upper Room of the Last Supper** and **King David's Tomb**, onto **St. Peter in Gallicantu Church** overlooking the **Kidron Valley** and **Caiaphas' House**. Just as the sun has set, participate in the **traditional Havdallah service** marking the end of the Sabbath, and the ushering in of the new week. This evening attend the **Sound & Light Show at the Tower of David**. (B,D)

DAY 7

Sunday, October 29, 2017

JERUSALEM

The morning begins in the **Jewish Quarter of the Old City** that was reconstructed after the city was unified at the conclusion of the Six-Day War in 1967. A special point of interest in the restored **Jewish Quarter** is the "**Cardo**", meaning the "**heart**" of this ancient Byzantine City. Visit the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Walk the **Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa**, through the **Ecce Homo Archway** for a **special service at St. Anne's Church**. Continue through the **Western Wall Tunnel**, experiencing 2,000 years of history. Next, visit the **Davidson Center** with its archeological park, one of the largest, most significant archaeological sites in Israel. Experience **Ir David, the City of David**, with an exciting journey both above and below ground through **excavations, fortresses and passageways**, through the **Canaanite tunnel** to complete the day. (B, D)

DAY 8

Monday, October 30, 2017

DEAD SEA

Today's full day leads into the **Judean wilderness** for a visit to **Masada**, the mountain top ruin of Herod's Palace

and the last fortress of the Jewish revolt against Rome. Onto **Qumran**, overlooking the caves where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered, followed by a **swim in the Dead Sea**. Return to Jerusalem. (B,D)

DAY 9

Tuesday, October 31, 2017

BETHLEHEM/JERUSALEM

Morning visit to **Bethlehem**, including the **Church of the Nativity, Manger Square** and **Shepherds Field**. Continue to **Mevasseret** for a unique opportunity to **meet with new immigrants from Ethiopia** at **YVEL**, and learn of the talented Jewelry institute, teaching them this beautiful trade and art form as a career. Afternoon visit to the unforgettable **Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem**. This evening, **Farewell Dinner**. (B,D)

DAY 10

Wednesday, November 1, 2017

JERUSALEM/ENROUTE


This morning, view **Israel's Parliament Knesset** grounds with its giant **Menorah**, followed by a visit to the **Shrine of the Book at the Israel Museum**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are housed. Included is the **Model of Ancient Jerusalem**, a miniature of the city during the building of the Second Temple. Continue to the **Friends of Zion Museum** dedicated to the outstanding contributions and support, by Christians, to the State of Israel. Conclude the last day in Jerusalem with **communion** at the **Garden Tomb**. Evening **transfer to the airport** with assistance in departure for flight to the United States. (B,D)

DAY 11

Thursday, November 2, 2017

USA

Arrival in the **United States**.
