(Facilitator Notes)

Daily Surrender

Surrender is defined as giving up the possession of something especially into the power of another. True surrender is when we don't know if the future or the outcome will be better or worse, but trusting God by giving all of our daily concerns to Him. It is simply believing that God will do what he said he will do. Daily surrender allows us to claim God's promises and experience His plan for our lives with peace, power, and purpose.

READ: Matthew 11:28 KTV, John 16:33 KJV Jesus extends a personal invitation to ALL who are carrying heavy burdens (worry, fear, guilt, responsibilities, relationships, etc.) to give it up to Him and he will give us peace.

- What are some burdens in your life that you can surrender, in exchange for peace? What is keeping you from giving up these burdens?

READ: Genesis 22:1-2, 9-18 KJV Abraham obeyed God and was willing to give up his only son that he loved so much. Abraham's obedience allowed God to bless Abraham and his family. Choosing to surrender to God allows us to live under His power and blessings.

- Describe a time when you surrendered or did not surrender to God. What was the outcome?

READ: Matthew 26:36-39 KJV, James 4:10 AMP Jesus knew the suffering that was ahead of him, but he surrendered to the will of God to fulfill God's purpose for his life, the purpose of saving us from our sins.

- What are we holding on to that is stopping you from fulfilling God's purpose in your life? What is God asking you to surrender today?
- **Time of Decision** (Everyone Bow Your Heads)
- **Receive Jesus as your Lord and Savior:**
- *Some may have never received Jesus *You may be a good person, give to the poor, serve in the community *Has there been a day where you confessed Jesus and Lord.
- **(Read Romans 10:9)** If need to make this decision, raise your hand:
- **What to do next:** Have them repeat after you: "I believe that Jesus is the son of God. I believe he died for me bearing my sins for me. I believe he rose from the dead and is alive right now. Dear Lord Jesus, come into my life now! Come into my heart now! I believe in my heart, and say with my mouth that Jesus Christ is my personal Lord as Savior. And I am, right now, born again."
- **Rededicate your life:**
- ***Is your life a mess** * Struggling in life, You know something is just off in life
- **{Read 1 John 1:9}** If you want to be restored with God, raise your hand:
- **What to do next:** Lead the person in the following prayer, allowing them to repent before God for the area they have sinned: "Father, I come before you in the Name of Jesus asking for forgiveness ... (allow the person to personally speak to God about the specific thing they are repenting for). After they are finished, close out the prayer with them, thanking God for forgiveness and restoration."
- **Time of Prayer**
- **Your Circle: (Family, Friends and those you have influence with) How's it going?**
- **Announcements-Next WOF service and any additional announcements**
- **Dismissal**

Prayer focus: 1) Your Circle (friends and family) 2) Small Group members 3) Word of Faith Leadership
