Promise Made Promise Kept Pt 2

God promised that Jesus would die on the cross for our sins. He promised that healing would be provided and that our iniquities would be placed on Him. We will discover who was involved in Jesus' crucifixion and the spark that ignited that event. Because this promise was kept Christians should, therefore, walk in the faith of God that Jesus died to give us.

READ: Isaiah 53:4-5 Here we see the promise that Jesus' crucifixion will save us from our sins and would also provide healing?

1. Describe how this promise being kept has changed your life.

READ: ST John 12:1,10- 11. Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead sparked the crucifixion.

1. Reflect on a time in your life when it seemed like it was over?

READ: ST John 11:47-48. The Sanhedrin feared that Lazarus' resurrection would jeopardize their position (John 11:48).

2. How are we supposed to deal with those who deliberately seek our demise?

Jesus died so that we can enjoy a life of victory through faith.

3. How do you accept and maintain your victory?

- **Time of Decision** (Everyone Bow Your Heads)

Receive Jesus as your Lord and Savior:

*Some may have never received Jesus *You may be a good person, give to the poor, serve in the community *Has there been a day where you confessed Jesus and Lord.

(Read Romans 10:9) If need to make this decision, raise your hand:

What to do next: Have them repeat after you: "I believe that Jesus is the son of God. I believe he died for me bearing my sins for me. I believe he rose from the dead and is alive right now. Dear Lord Jesus, come into my life now! Come into my heart now! I believe in my heart, and say with my mouth that Jesus Christ is my personal Lord as Savior. And I am, right now, born again."

Rededicate your life:

*Is your life a mess *Struggling in life *You know something is just off in life

{Read 1 John 1:9} If you want to be restored with God, raise your hand:

What to do next: Lead the person in the following prayer, allowing them to repent before God for the area they have sinned:

"Father, I come before you in the Name of Jesus asking for forgiveness ... (allow the person to personally speak to God about the specific thing they are repenting for). After they are finished, close out the prayer with them, thanking God for forgiveness and restoration."

- **Time of Prayer**
- **Your Circle: (Family, Friends and those you have influence with) How's it going?**
- **Announcements-Next WOF service and any additional announcements**
- **Dismissal**
