Restoring Family Traditions

Family traditions are important to our community. Traditions are customs or beliefs that are initiated by members of the family and passed on from generation to generation. These customs or beliefs bring families together and enable people to reconnect. Family traditions provide a sense of comfort, teach values, connect generations and create lasting memories which contributes to a strong community. Legacy focuses on what will endure; living intentionally and aiming to build into the next generations for their success and is for those with and without children.

READ Deuteronomy 6: 4-13 NLT, Ephesians 6:4 NIV

Moses was called by God to instruct the people of God. He gave them guiding truths by instruction and example. This instruction was to be passed down from generation to generation.

2. How can you contribute to bringing and keeping your family strong?

READ: Philippians 4:9 NLT, 2 Timothy 2:2 NLT Legacy must be front and center in building traditions in family. In addition, we must seek to build in godly, integrity and trustworthiness.

4. What inheritance or tradition are you leaving for the next generation?

READ: Joel 2:25-27 NKJV, John 15:9-17 NLT
