'LEVEL UP' – The Road to Emmaus**

FUN TIME: “Hidden Object”

What You Will Need: Download and print the hidden pictures page.

What You Will Do: As a family, work together to find the hidden objects on the page.

BIBLE TIME:

(Once you have found all the hidden objects) Discuss how sometimes, something is right in front of us and we don't see it! That's kind of like Jesus, right? We don't see Jesus, but we know Jesus is with us all the time. Today, we're going to see some men who had Jesus walking with them. He was right in front of their faces, but they still couldn't see Him. Let's take a look at our Bible story and find out what happened.

READ: Luke 24:13-35

Familiarize yourself with the Bible passage and summarize it for your younger children. Read it with older children. For toddlers and preschoolers, simply share the answers to these questions with them as you summarize the Bible story. Keep it short and sweet for them 😊.

1. Who came up to the two men as they were walking? Did they recognize this person?
2. What did they talk about as they walked to Emmaus?
3. When did they realize they were with Jesus?
4. How do you think they felt when they suddenly realized they were with Jesus the whole time?
5. Describe a time when you felt lonely even though there were other people around you.
6. How do you feel knowing Jesus is alw

REAL TIME: Today, we are continuing our series, 'Level Up'. We want to 'level up' in our faith in God. This means trusting His love for us and His faithfulness to us no matter what we face. This can be hard when it seems like God is nowhere to be found. In today's Bible story, these men were feeling lost and scared. They were so wrapped up in how bad things looked that they didn't realize that Jesus was with them along the entire walk and they didn't even recognize Jesus! It was only when they stopped for the evening and ate together did they realize it had been Jesus the entire time!

This is also true today. Even though we can't see Jesus, Jesus is always with us. Jesus talks to us through our church teachers. Jesus shows love to us whenever we get a hug or when we do something kind for someone else. When we are sad, like Jesus' friends were on the road to Emmaus, Jesus is right there next to us and gives us comfort. No matter what the situation is, **Jesus is always with me (and you)!**

Read Psalm 139:7 (NIRV). Where can we go where Jesus can't find us? That's right – nowhere! This Bible verse tells us that no matter where we go, Jesus is always with us. Don't ever forget that. Let's pray.

PRAYER TIME: “Dear Heavenly Father, thank You for reminding us that Jesus, thank You so much for reminding us each and every day that You are always with us and will never leave us. In Jesus' Name, amen!”
