'30 DAYS OF PRAYER' – You and Me, Let's Agree!**

FUN TIME: “3 to 3”

What You Will Need: 3 bean bags or balls, a starting & finish line. *(If you have enough players to make teams of 3 people, you will need one bean bag or ball for each person. This game will also work with only 2 people.)*

What You Will Do: Today, we are going to juggle... sounds simple enough, right? Nope. Each group of three has 3 bean bags. Each person should have one bean bag. You will have to juggle, as a team to the finish line. You cannot have more than one bean bag in your hand at a time or drop a bean bag.

Have the teams line up, choose where they have to fast walk (preferably a pretty good distance away) and then fast walk back to the starting line. If anyone has more than one bean bag in their hand at a time or drops a bean bag - the team must start over! The team who is able to do this the fastest, wins! If there are only 2 people, work together to make it to the finish line as fast as you can.

BIBLE TIME:

That was tough wasn't it? You *really* had to work together in order to make progress and try to win. Today, we are going to talk about the Prayer of Agreement. How is that prayer like the game we just played? *(Allow for responses)*. It took all three of you to get in sync or agreement with each other in order to move in the right direction & win. Likewise, this type of prayer requires cooperation or agreement between you and the person praying with you. Let's find out how the Prayer of Agreement increases our prayer power and gets awesome things done!

READ: Acts 12:1-17

Familiarize yourself with the Bible passage and summarize it for your younger children. Read it with older children. For toddlers and preschoolers, simply share the answers to these questions with them as you summarize the Bible story. Keep it short and sweet for them



1. What was the Church doing while Peter was in prison?
2. How did Peter get out of prison?
3. Who did Peter say delivered him from Herod and the Jews who were trying to hurt him?
4. When Peter got to Mary's house, what were the people doing?

REAL TIME: The prayer of agreement increases our prayer power. God was able to free Peter from prison in a special way because people were praying together, in agreement, for him. God is able to help us, and others, in ways we would never have imagined. We can get our prayers answered alone, but sometimes we need extra help, like Peter did. Those praying for him were in agreement and God answered their prayers to help him. God will do the same for us. All we need is God's promise about what we need and someone to agree with us that His Word is true and He will do what He promised. Then we need to pray together and God will do it!

Read Matthew 18:19 (NIV). Let's read our Memory Verse. This verse tells us that if two people agree about anything they ask for, God will do it. You, the other person and God make the Team of 3 that you need.

God, you and someone who agrees with you in prayer is a force that cannot be stopped! This shows us again how powerful agreement can be. So, let's use this power to help someone else. There are people who need help, they need God. Do you know anyone we can pray in agreement for? *(Allow for responses)*. We can also use it for ourselves. Who needs something from God? *(Allow for responses)* Let's agree with one another and God's Word and pray now.

PRAYER TIME: “Father God, thank You that we can pray in agreement with others and You will do what we ask in line with Your Word. Please show us who to pray for. Thank You for hearing us. In Jesus’ Name, amen!”
