SING! - God Forgives Me!**

FUN TIME: Fact or Fiction

INSTRUCTIONS: Read the following statements. Have your children see if they can tell which is fact and which is fiction. Encourage them to give some sentences of their own too and see if anyone can guess.

- Nemo is a puffer fish (False)
- Broccoli was once banned from the White House (True)
- Donald Duck's sister is named Donna. (False)
- People in Japan eat Kentucky Fried Chicken for Christmas dinner. (True)
- Porcupines can float. (True)

It can be hard to tell when something is or isn't true. Sometimes, we tell people things that aren't true that isn't a game. The Bible calls this lying and it is a sin. A sin is disobeying God. When we do anything, no matter how 'big' or 'small' that God tells us not to do, it is a sin. When we don't do what God tells us to do, that's sin too.

BIBLE TIME: Today, we're going to talk about what we must do with our sins. God expects us to follow Him and His Word: The B-I-B -L - E. When we don't obey God, we miss out on His best for us. We also begin to feel sad and guilty and all yucky in our hearts. In today's Bible passage, we will see what David did with his sins.

READ: Psalm 32

Familiarize yourself with the Bible passage and summarize it for your younger children. Read it with older children. For toddlers and preschoolers, simply share the answers to these questions with them as you summarize the Bible story. Keep it short and sweet for them 😊.

1. What happened when David tried to cover up his sin?
2. What did he do for God to forgive his sin?
3. What does it mean to confess?
4. According to this passage, what kind of person is blessed?
5. What do we need to do when we mess up?

REAL TIME: Read 1 John 1:9 The Bible says we can confess our sins to God. That means we can tell God what we've done wrong, apologize, and choose to do things His way. We can also ask for help to do the right thing next time. What makes it hard for you to confess when you do something wrong? How do you know God forgives you when you confess your sin? Let's go to Him now with anything that we have done wrong. He will forgive us every time, when we ask Him and mean it from our hearts.

PRAYER TIME: Dear God, thank You for loving me. I confess what I've done wrong (*say it quietly between you and God*) and ask for Your forgiveness. Help me to do the right thing. Thank You for forgiving me. In Jesus' Name, amen.
