How to Surrender

Surrendering is a battle term. It implies giving up all right to the conqueror. Surrendering to God is setting aside our own plans and eagerly giving Him full control of every part of our lives. It requires us to choose whether to follow our own sinful inclinations or to seek God's way of being right and doing right. Surrender to God requires self-examine and submission. God's plan for us is always in our best interest.

READ: Proverb 3:5-6 NLT, Psalms 37:3-5 AMPC Trusting God with all of our hearts is a decision to give up our thinking and put our confidence in God's love for us. This allows God to lead us in the right direction, through every situation.

- 1. Name some of the causes/affects of lack of trust.
- 2. What are the impacts of this? How can we develop our trust?

READ: Jeremiah 29:11, Proverbs 14:12 - God's plan for our lives is GOOD; leading to a desirable outcome. On the contrary, our own plans can lead to destruction.

- 3. Share a time in your life you decided to act without seeking God first, what was the outcome?
- 4. Share a time God told you to do something, you did it, and others benefited from your obedience.

READ: 2 Corinthians 5:17 NKJV, Romans 6:11-14 NLT - The more we surrender to God, the more our old nature is replaced. We become more like Christ.

- 6. What steps will you take to obey God and follow His will, way and purpose for your life?
