## THE BLESSINGS OF THE LORD ARE FREE!

The Blessings of the Lord are free, without charge to the recipient. Webster's 1828 Dictionary defines blessings as God's favor and protection; any means of happiness pronounced; a gift, benefit or advantage; that which promotes prosperity and welfare; a present or a gift either because it was attended with kind wishes for the welfare of the giver, or because it was the means of increasing happiness. Often people show compassion for others by random acts of kindness. These acts provide hope into people's hearts by reminding them that others care. Jesus paid for our sins so that we might be free. Through Christ, God has provided us with many blessings that are without cost to us.

**Read Proverbs 10:22 AMP, Numbers 6:24-26 AMP** The blessing of the Lord brings increase that is unconditional. You owe nothing!

- 2. Share a time you've gone the extra mile to be an unconditional blessing. How was it received?
