

KBM WORD OF FAITH MILITARY MISSIONS DOING THE WORK!

On October 25, 2025, ahead of Hurricane Melissa, the NAS Pensacola command chaplain reached out to KBM Word of Faith Missions Operative for the military, Pastor AnJolo Fielder, for assistance in supporting evacuees from Naval Station



Guantanamo Bay. KBM quickly mobilized to provide vital support, bringing equipment, groceries, and resources to prepare hot meals for the evacuees and NAS Pensacola staff.



The evacuees began their evacuation around 4:00 AM that Saturday and did not land in Pensacola until approximately 9:00 PM. Flights continued throughout the night and into the following morning, with multiple arrivals until 11:30 AM on Sunday. The primary meal provided was chicken nuggets and French fries, though other options were also available. The evacuees were deeply grateful for the nourishing food after going the entire day without a proper meal.

In total, the effort fed between 1,100 and 1,300 personnel, including both the evacuees and the NAS Pensacola staff who assisted with the evacuation.

This effort was part of KBM Word of Faith’s ongoing military outreach in Pensacola, where they have been hosting weekly Bible studies for military personnel at NAS Pensacola, NAS Corry Station, and NAS Whiting Field since 2021. The same dedicated volunteers who served during the evacuation have also been consistently involved in these Bible studies.

This coordinated response ensured that the evacuees received both nourishment and spiritual support, highlighting the community’s commitment to the military.

You Did it *Again!*

Thanks to all the volunteers and supporters of Word of Faith Cares 2025 Community Event. Because of you we had a very successful event. 375 volunteers assisted community organizations throughout Metropolitan Detroit.

The organizations supported are **Fish and Loaves**, Urban Development Corporation, **Vista Maria**, Detroit Rescue Mission – Genesis II, **Detroit Rescue Mission – Genesis III**, Detroit Rescue Mission – Men’s Shelter, **Great Lakes Crossing Nursing Home**, Cass Community Social Services, **Forgotten Harvest (AM & PM)**, Kids Coalition Against Hunger – Hagin Gym, **Operation Donation – Children’s Hospital of Michigan**, Oak Park High School Ronald McDonald House, **Salvation Army**, Farmington Days for Girls, **Capuchin Kitchen**, Goodwill.

WOF Cares volunteers assisted with packing food, making meal packages, distributing meals, cleaning & painting, performing yard work, beautification of neighborhoods, cleaning up athletic facilities, preparing hygiene kits, preparing Thanksgiving boxes, cleaning windows, dusting walls and statues, polishing pews, chairs and doors, mopping floors, vacuuming carpet, and washing wheelchairs.

Word of Faith Cares *Highlights*


- ♥ **Kids Coalition Against Hunger** – 125 volunteers (Parents & Kids) showed up and prepared & packed 10,260 meals. This was done by using four (4) assembly stations that were set up in the Hagin Gym. The families loved the event, including a grandmother.
- ♥ **Forgotten Harvest** – Volunteers packed 1,216 Boxes that will feed 2,239 families.
- ♥ **Fish and Loaves** – Served perishable food to 700 families. Volunteers got to see a massive amount of fresh food being distributed to the community.
- ♥ **Operation Donation Children’s Hospital of Michigan** – Over 1,000 stuffed animals were donated. Children’s Hospital of Michigan was very thankful to WOF and joyfully overwhelmed with the donation.
- ♥ **Oak Park High** – Small Groups cleaned the athletic facilities.
- ♥ **Great Lakes Nursing Home** – Washed the residents wheelchairs.

2025 Ministry Finances


