Epic! - The Twelve Spies

FUN TIME: Fruits of the Land (All ages)

Share a snack of grapes, pomegranates or any fruit you and your children enjoy.

<u>BIBLE TIME:</u> As you are enjoying it, talk about how God promised the children of Israel a place that was filled with goodies so much better than these! God always keeps His promises so we can trust God. Today, we're going to talk about how two men did just that, trusted God!

Use the Bible verses and questions below to discuss this with your children. For toddlers and preschoolers, simply share the answers to these questions with them as you read the Bible story. Keep it short and sweet for them \mathfrak{D} .

- Familiarize yourself with Numbers 13:1 14:9. Briefly summarize the story for younger children. For older children, take the time to read it. Discuss the difference between how Joshua and Caleb's viewpoint of the land was different than the other spies.
- 2. **Ask:** Has there been a time when things seemed scary, or where you felt like you were too small or too young to overcome it? What did you do?
- 3. **Read Joshua 1:9 (NLT)** In light of this verse, what can we do when things seem scary or too much? (Share a time when you trusted God and He kept His promise)

REAL TIME: We can trust God. He will always do what He has promised and He is more powerful than anything that would try to make us afraid. Is there anything that is trying to make you afraid? Let's talk to God about it and choose to trust Him to help.

PRAYER TIME: "Heavenly Father, thank You for keeping Your promises. Right now, I need help with (name the issue). I ask that You show me what to do. I trust what You say and choose to be strong and courageous and not afraid. Because You are with me, I know it will be alright as I trust and follow You. In Jesus' Name, Amen!"
